1a. Who is running the Free Kids Fun Sports on the oval today? Shape Creators

1b. What is your speedometer reading at the start: Finish:

Direction: A correct answer for 1c. is vital as you start the course. Travel straight until you can feel your purse strings tighten (and can go no further).

Direction: Backtracking over common grounds will lead you to your final destination - you will be right if you take the first street beginning with the 16th letter of the alphabet.
